- [1] LD GE A: (Basic Subjects) & B (Math) must be completed with C- or higher & by 60 units earned.
- [2] One American Institution course will also count for LD GE D.
- [3] Major course includes a lab. Meets LD GE B science lab requirement.
- [4] Complete 2 DCG courses, (one must be domestic) with courses that also meet GE.
- [5] Credit earned may not count toward unit requirements for graduation, GE or major.
- [6] A career-focused minor, certificate, internship, and/or field school is highly recommended – consult advisor and faculty in your specialty area; Consult with a with minor advisor and start any series early enough to finish.
- [7] Take at least 9 units major electives (usually 3 courses) in a chosen specialization area, and at least 3 units (usually 1 course) from each of the other two areas - Arch Specialization: ANTH 351-354; 357-359; Bioanth Specialization: ANTH 331-335, 339; Sociocultural Specialization: ANTH 315-317; ANTH 329, 340,341.
- [8] Take at least two of three methods courses, ANTH 318/330/350 - a third can count as a major elective.
