[1] LD GE A: (Basic Subjects) & B (Math) must be completed with C- or higher & by 60 units earned.

[2] One American Institution course will also count for LD GE D.

[3] One science course must include a lab.

[4] Complete 2 DCG courses, (one must be domestic) with courses that also meet GE.

[5] Credit earned for remedial math will not count toward unit requirements for graduation, GE or major.

[6] If you select ESM 230 for methodology course, take STAT 108 or 109 for GE B: math

[7] A minor approved by your geography major advisor is required

Six systematic geography courses (18-22 units) are required, including one course from each of the systematic emphasis areas (the Human World, the Physical Environment, Geospatial Systems).

8) Choose from the following physical environment courses: GEOG 301, GEOG 302, GEOG 352, GEOG 353, GEOG 357, GEOG 473, GEOL 306 (UD GE B), WSHD 310

9) Choose from the following human cultural courses: GEOG 300, GEOG 304, GEOG 360 GEOG 363, GEOG 365, GEOG 470, GEOG 471

10) Geospatial Systems courses GSP 216, GSP 270, GSP 316, GSP 326, GSP 370, GSP 416

[11] Select a minimum of two upper division depth experience courses

[12] Select one regional synthesis course: GEOG 309, GEOG 319, GEOG 322, GEOG 332, GEOG 335, GEOG 344, GEOG 375, GEOG 472

[13] Students are encouraged to specialize in one area of systematic geography by taking at least two of the remaining three required systematic courses in one emphasis area
