- (4) Complete 2 DCG courses, (one must be domestic) with courses that also meet GE.
- (5) Recommended for humanities: PHIL 104 (DCG-n), PHIL 106, PHIL 107
- [6] PHIL 341, 342, 343 should be taken in sequence.
- [7] PHIL 420 & 425 should not be taken until senior year.
- [8] Two from PHIL 301, 304, 306, 309B, 355, 415, or 485. Three units of PHIL 391 may be used in lieu of one of the electives and must be approved by the department chair for credit. Note that PHIL 306, if selected, will also meet DCG domestic.
