- (1) LD GE A: (Basic Subjects) & B (Math) must be completed with C- or higher & by 60 units earned.
- (2) One American Institution course will also count for LD GE D.
- (3) One science course must include a lab.
- (4) Complete 2 DCG courses, (one must be domestic) with courses that also meet GE.
- (5) Credit earned for remedial math will not count toward unit requirements for graduation, GE or major.
- [6] Take one core or breadth course w/lab or discussion: PSYC 311D, PSYC 320, PSYC 324D, PSYC 325, PSYC 335D, PSYC 337D, PSYC 345L
- [7] Take one of the following capstone courses: PSYC 485, PSYC 486, PSYC 487, PSYC 488, PSYC 490. Capstone may be taken fall or spring of senior year.
- [8] Select 18 units from core content: PSYC 311, PSYC 321, PSYC 322, PSYC 323, PSYC 324, PSYC 335, PSYC 337, PSYC 438
- [9] Select 12 units from breadth requirements. See psychology program description in the catalog. Some courses also count toward UD GE D and GE E. If double-count courses are not selected, take UD GE D and/or GE E courses in place of electives.

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
