(1) LD GE A: (Basic Subjects) & B (Math) must be completed with C- or higher & by 60 units earned.

(2) One American Institution course will also count for LD GE D.

(3) One science course must include a lab.

(4) Complete 2 DCG courses, (one must be domestic) with courses that also meet GE.

(5) Credit earned for remedial math will not count toward unit requirements for graduation, GE or major.

[6] If you know what major(s) you are interested in – enroll in the required introductory major course(s) from that major's Major Academic Plan (MAP) or take an additional GE course of interest or the course can be one that does not meet a GE requirement but is based on your interests. Choose a 100 or 200 level course in a major that interests you. (See the major program description and/or major academic plan for possible introductory course offerings.)
